AN ORDINANCE

6429

VACATING A PORTION OF POPLAR & WEBB STREET IN THE FIFTH WARD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSPORT AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE SAME THAT:

SECTION I:

The following portion of Poplar Street beginning at South Alley and moving South to Webb Street and the portion of Webb Street from West Alley moving West to Poplar Street in the Fifth Ward of the City of Williamsport, County of Lycoming, Pennsylvania as described as follows is hereby vacated.

Beginning at a point, the intersection formed by the southern side of South Alley and the western line of Poplar Street. Thence from said point of the beginning, across Poplar Street, S 87° 13' 22" E a distance of 40.15', to a point on the eastern line of Poplar St. Thence along the lands of Gair the following two courses and distance.

- 1) S 07° 46' 27" W distance of 167.21' to a point.
- 2) S 89° 44' 36" E a distance of 148.64' to a point on the northern line of Webb St.

Thence across Webb St. S 08° 32' 12" W a distance of 40.42' to a point on the southern line Webb St. Thence along and/or through the lands of the Reading Company N 89° 44' 36" W a distance of 188.45', to a point. Thence along other lands of Gair, N 07° 46' 27" E a distance of 209.34' to a point, the point and place of beginning.

Containing 0.328 acre of land.

SECTION II.

The proper City officials are hereby authorized and directed to reflect the above-mentioned change on the official map of the City of Williamsport.

SECTION III.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance shall become effective upon final enactment.
