

Re: 2018-2019 State Fire Grant

In January of 2019 the Williamsport Bureau of Fire received the 2018-2019 State Fire Grant. We were awarded \$14,811.36 dollars to use for our specified projects. This money has been marked for new pagers (\$5,000) and a new command vehicle (\$10,000).

This year's allocations totaling \$14,811.36 will be divided between two separate purchases:

- (1) We will be upgrading our pagers through Keystone Communications with the purchase of 12 new Motorola VI's along with spare batteries for a total purchase price of \$5,017.00.
- (2) We are currently finalizing an agreement with TRM Emergency Vehicle Specialist on the design and build of our new command vehicle. TRM is a Co-stars participating vendor and is a one-stop shop for this kind of specialized vehicle. We have a ceiling of \$55,000.00 earmarked for this vehicle with a 4 year payment plan budgeted using State grant monies along with a portion of it coming from our Vehicle Maintenance line item #76010.
