Resolution Honoring Lycoming County Law Association

Whereas, on December 1, 1869, a group of distinguished Lycoming County attorneys recognized the need to promote "kind and social relations, professional courtesy and urbanity" to its members and to assist them "in acquiring legal knowledge and correct practice," and petitioned to incorporate the Lycoming Law Association;

Whereas, this year the Lycoming Law Association is celebrating the 150th anniversary of its existence;

Whereas, the first president of the Lycoming Law Association was Robert Fleming, and the association had just thirteen charter members attending the first meeting;

Whereas, Christian Frey is serving the Lycoming Law Association as its 118th president and the association has approximately two hundred members;

Whereas, throughout its history the Lycoming Law Association has provided valuable services and resources to both members and the community;

Whereas, the Lycoming Reporter was established as the legal journal of Lycoming County in 1949 and its first editor was Malcom Muir, who served in that capacity for twenty years;


Whereas, the Lycoming Reporter publishes weekly and includes legal notices and summaries of the opinions issued by the Lycoming County Court of Common Pleas;


Whereas, this year the Lycoming Law Association Foundation, the charitable wing of the Lycoming Law Association, is celebrating the 30th anniversary of its existence;




