TITLE

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXCAVATION OF CERTAIN STREETS FOR A WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT BY THE CITY OF WILLIAMSPORT FOR THE WILLIAMSPORT MUNICIPAL WATER AUTHORITY.

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinance, Part Nine: Streets, Utilities and Public Service Code specifically Article 901: Street Excavation projects are required to be permanently restored within 60 days but at no time later than when the asphalt plants close for the season.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, may allow street projects to be extended upon written request.


WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, has received a written request from the Williamsport Municipal Water Authority for the Thomas Avenue Water Main Replacement project. (See attachment)

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, shall require all cuts to match existing base course or a minimum of 6" whichever is greater to top of road surface when base material becomes available in accordance with City of Williamsport Street Restoration specification drawings. High performance cold patch will be utilized to top of road instead of cold patch for the winter season.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, may place certain conditions in order to insure the work is completed in a proper and /or timely manner.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Williamsport, Pennsylvania, that Williamsport Municipal Water Authority will complete the milling and overlay of the Thomas Avenue project in conjunction with the City of Williamsport prior to the asphalt plants closing in the fall of 2020.

Mr. Girardi,

The Williamsport Municipal Water Authority has received (5 November, 2019) from the City, a list of paving projects to be completed during the upcoming construction season. The Authority plans to complete water main replacement projects prior to the City paving project in order to improve our infrastructure and prevent future intrusions into newly paved roads. Due to the Street Cut Moratorium which limits the time frame for completing work in the associated area, the Authority requests access for construction activities before the 1 April, 2020 start date.

The Authority is requesting early access to initiate work for water main replacement on Huffman Street and Thomas Avenue beginning in February. This work is minimally disruptive to traffic with most of the excavation occurring in low traffic areas. The areas will be temporarily restored as paving is expected to directly follow the project completions this spring.
