RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATIONS WITH THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION

Resolution authorizing the filing of applications with the Federal Transit Administration, an operating administration of the United States Department of Transportation, for Federal transportation assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53, and/or authorized by any other Federal statutes administered by the Federal Transit Administration, including, but not limited to, applicable sections of 23 U.S.C. Chapter 23.

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administrator has been delegated authority to award Federal financial assistance for a public transportation project; and,

WHEREAS, the grant or cooperative agreement for Federal financial assistance will impose certain obligations upon the Applicant and may require the Applicant to provide the local share of the project cost; and,


WHEREAS, the Applicant has or will provide all annual certifications and assurances to the Federal Transit Administration required for the project; and,

WHEREAS, the Applicant is the Designated Recipient as defined by 49 U.S.C. § 5302(4) to request and receive Urbanized Area Formula Program assistance as authorized by 49 U.S.C. § 5307, either alone or in addition to other Federal assistance administered by the Federal Transit Administration.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WILLIAMSPORT CITY COUNCIL:

1. That Derek Slaughter, Mayor or his designee, is authorized to execute and file an application for Federal assistance on behalf of the City of Williamsport with the Federal Transit Administration for Federal assistance authorized by 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53, and/or authorized by any other Federal statutes administered by the Federal Transit Administration, including, but not limited to, applicable sections of 23 U.S.C. Chapter 23.



Attached for your review for the upcoming March 5th City Council meeting is the following resolution which is required by the Federal Transit Administration as part of RVT's annual operating, capital and planning grant application process.

This resolution updates the changes in administration as well as authorizes the City of Williamsport – Bureau of Transportation to file grant applications with the Federal Transit Administration. This resolution was previously adopted by City Council on February 2, 2017, and needs to be updated at least every 7 years to reflect authority under current public transportation legislations (49 USC Chapter 53), currently the FAST ACT.

We are requesting that action be taken on this resolution on Thursday, March 5, 2020.
