RVT is requesting approval for Disposition of eight (8) transit buses;

- 1- 1986 GMC accessible 35' transit vehicle (502)
- 2- 1996 NFA accessible 40' transit vehicle (801 & 802)
- 1- 1990 TMC-RTS accessible 40' transit vehicle (601)
- 2- 2001 NFA accessible 35' transit vehicles (901 & 902)
- 2- 2003 NFA accessible 35' transit vehicle (906&905)
- 1- 2005 GILLIG accessible 35' transit vehicle (1101)
- 1- 2009 CHEVY ARBOC accessible cutaway bus (910)

These vehicles have met their useful service life and/or mileage and have been out of service at RVT for Maintenance and Safety failures. As we have scavenged all useful parts from these vehicles as we can, they are at the point to remove them from the property. These vehicles are also awaiting Disposition Authorization from the FTA, once authorized, RVT will place all on Public Surplus Auction site with little reserve as all are in non-operating conditions.

RVT is requesting approval for Disposition of eight (8) transit support vehicles

- 1-2003 FORD Expedition SUV (14)
- 1- 2002 CHEVY Astro Van (13)
- 1-2009 CHEVY 2500 Van (6)
- 1-2002 CHEVY Malibu sedan (12)

These vehicles have met their useful service life and have also mechanical or safety issues that will not allow use. They will be placed on Public surplus Auction and if no sale is issued will be donated to the WAHS Tech program for further training education for the program.
