HONORING FIRE CHIEF TODD HECKMAN

WHEREAS, *Fire Chief Todd Heckman* served with distinction on March 31, 2019 for a reported structure fire with possible entrapment at 45 Huffman Ave, City of Williamsport.

WHEREAS, *Chief Todd Heckman* was returning home when he saw smoke coming from a structure at 45 Huffman Avenue and was advised that a woman was trapped on the second floor.

WHEREAS, *Chief Todd Heckman* initially attempted to enter through the stairs but was driven back by smoke and flames. A neighbor retrieved a ladder that was raised to the front porch roof and after climbing the ladder, Chief Heckman heard the woman banging on the second floor window. Chief Heckman broke the window with his portable radio and pulled the woman onto the porch roof. When firefighters and police officers arrived they raised another ladder and assisted the woman down the ladder where she was taken to EMS crews, transported to UPMC Susquehanna and treated for smoke inhalation, exposure and lacerations to her feet.

WHEREAS, as a result of the dedication and service of *Chief Todd Heckman*, the City of Williamsport, County of Lycoming, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, is left with a proud past along with a more promising future; and




