AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING SAINT JAMES PLACE

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMSPORT AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: The public street now designated as Allen Street, between Cemetery Street and the Pajama Factory where Allen Street turns northerly, be hereinafter designated as Saint James Place.

SECTION II: The proper city officials are hereby authorized and directed to make such designation upon the official map of the City of Williamsport.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final enactment.

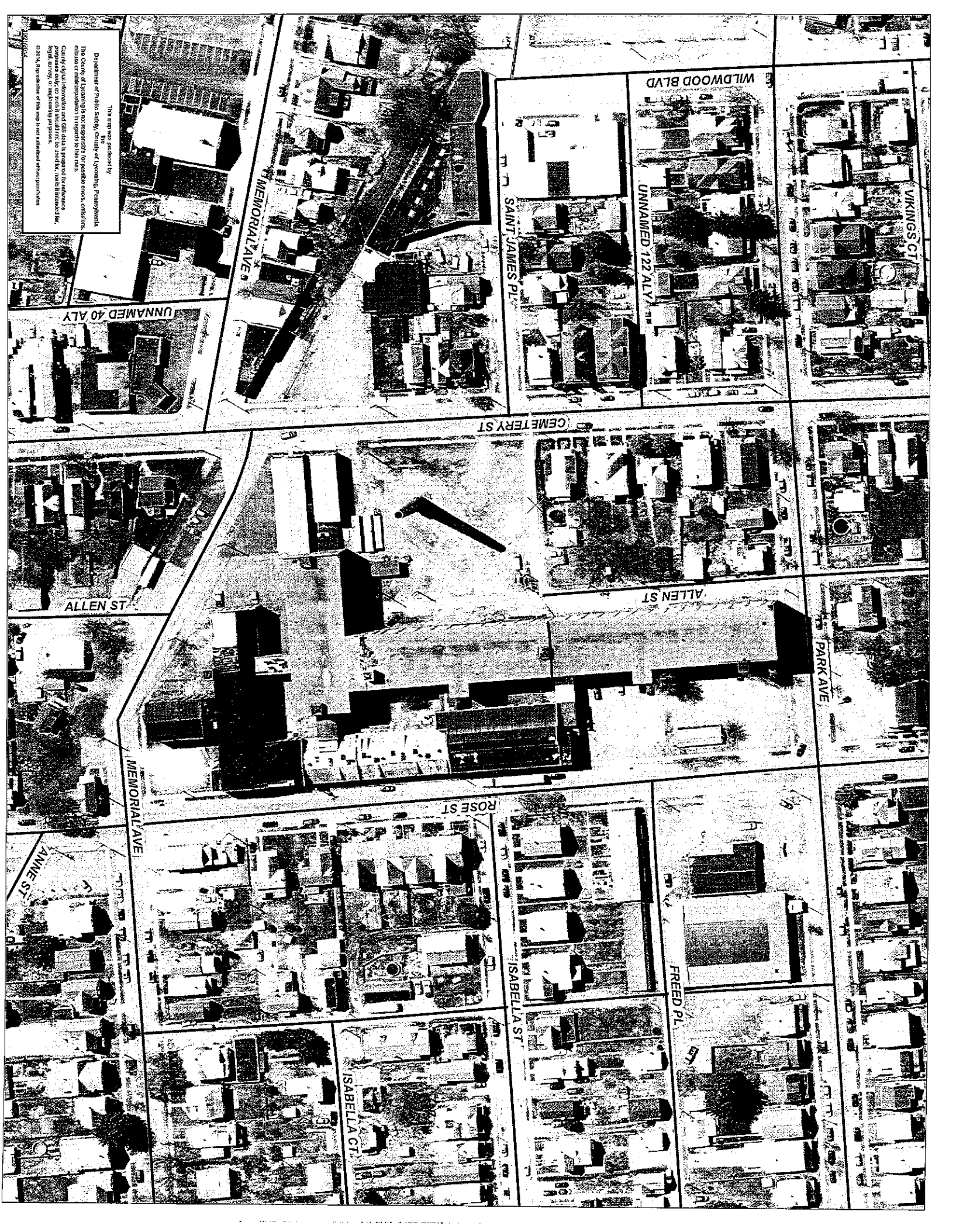
Please see the attached map. The segment highlighted in yellow is the segment in question. We are suggesting that we extend St James Place to where the section highlighted in yellow turns 90 degrees to Allen St. I zoomed the map out so you can see that Allen St does indeed extend north and south of the Pajama Factory parcel. Also, there are no addressed points on the segment of road. No one would have to change their address. The only change would be moving the Allen St sign that is currently at the intersection of Cemetery St and the segment we are referring to. Please let me know if you need anything else.
